700 cyclists will take part in the fourth edition of the Circuit of the Cotswolds on Sunday 22nd June.

The challenging 100-mile event is organised to professional standards with a signposted route, three feeding stations, electronic timing, support vehicles and paramedic cover.

It commemorates the life of David Ryan, a brilliant physicist and keen racing cyclist. At the time of his death in 2004, he had just been awarded a \$2 million grant for his project to develop new generation MRI cancer scanners.

All profits are shared between Yorkshire Cancer Research, Britain's largest medical research charity, and Helen & Douglas House hospices for children and young people in Oxford.
